

Do NOT rely on GPS or Mapquest.

- 1 . Take Hwy 17 to Mount Hermon road exit in Scotts Valley. The Bear Creek exit is NOT RECOMMENDED although it is shown on the map. If coming from Santa Cruz you can also go Graham Hill Road to Felton if you prefer.
- 2 . Stay on Mount Hermon road all the way through Scotts Valley and down into Felton. There are two right turn lanes at the signal in Felton. Stay in the far right lane. Turn right onto Graham Hill Road.
- 3 . Take the next right onto Hwy 9 North, and drive about 6 miles to central Boulder Creek.
- 4 . At the stop sign, turn Left onto Hwy 236, also called Big Basin Way. (There is a gas station on your Left and a Round Table Pizza on your right at this intersection).
- 5 . Stay on 236 for 6.6 miles, and then turn left onto Little Basin Road. (People sometimes miss this turn. So here are more details about this part. After about 6 miles on Hwy 236, you will pass Lodge Road on the right, then a big hand painted sign that says "Firewood". From this point continue about ½ mile, watching for the sign for Little Basin Road and a small Little Basin sign on the left. Sempervirens Outdoor School is right next to this road, but make sure you turn onto the road not their driveway.)
- 6 . Stay on Little Basin Road for about 2 miles to the main entrance of Little Basin. (There are a couple of unlabeled side roads, but just stay on the main paved, though bumpy, road. You will go under a big "Little Basin" sign through an open gate with intimidating no trespassing signs, but keep going. Bear right and go through a second **open** gate staying on the paved road to enter the site.)
- 7 . Once you enter the site, follow the signs for AEOE parking, check-in and registration.
